

Guidelines for Submission of Art

These guidelines are to inform artists of the process of submission for those wishing to exhibit in the art gallery at the Anglican Church of St. George the Martyr in Simpsonville, South Carolina.

Submission: Artists should submit artwork to the church on the specified dates. Should include information regarding the medium, dimensions, and price of each piece. Bring them to:

Notification: Artists will be notified by phone or e-mail if their work is accepted or denied. If denied, work must be picked up on the specified date.

St. George the Martyr Church Responsibilities:

1. Specify dates of exhibition.
2. Design and securely install the exhibit.
3. Produce the exhibition list and price list.
4. Host an opening reception in conjunction with the exhibit.
5. Create a press release and send a press announcement to Upstate media.

Exhibitor Responsibilities:

1. Submit 2 or 3 pieces which will include title of piece, medium, size and price.
2. Prepare artwork for hanging including suitable framing. We also have some space for small easels.
3. Transport artwork to and from St. George the Martyr Church. Removal of unsold art is the responsibility of the artist within two days of the final closing date of the exhibition.
4. Engage in an artist dialogue and/or presentation at the opening reception.

Financial Considerations: All work is for sale and exhibitors are encouraged to give a tithe of 10% of the proceeds to St. George the Martyr. Sales will be transacted directly between the artists and interested buyers.

Agreement: All artwork selected for exhibition will remain for the duration of the show, unless other arrangements have been requested by the purchaser.
